

Longy Faculty Union Initial Union Proposal Presented 6/29/10

ARTICLE ____

PARKING

A. Parking shall be available in Longy lots (or other parking spaces as controlled by Longy) on a first-come, first-served basis to faculty with valid Longy parking stickers. Parking stickers shall be available at the front office. The following restrictions on parking in the lots shall apply:

1. Parking in Longy's lots is permitted only while conducting business at the School.
2. Parking stickers for the year shall be issued to faculty members in the fall after they have submitted their individual contract for the year.
3. Longy parking stickers shall not be available to faculty members who reside in Cambridge who are expected to use their resident parking permit to park near Longy in order to keep the lots available for those coming from outside of Cambridge.
4. To keep the Zabriskie House lot available for faculty, the administration will make every effort to provide off-campus parking for guests conducting business at the School.
5. Independent building and construction contractors will not make use of Longy parking lots, except for unloading and loading of materials.
6. The Zabriskie House lot is a faculty only lot, available on a first-come, first-served basis during regular Longy building hours.
7. The Rey-Waldstein Building lot is available to faculty *only on Saturdays and Sundays* on a first-come, first-served basis during regular Longy building hours. Cars shall be parked four across and three deep to maximize the number of spaces. Faculty members are required to leave a note on the dashboard indicating their teaching location and cell phone number, if available, so that the owners of blocked cars can depart as necessary.

B. Longy shall continue to pay for a limited number of spaces at the Armenian Church located at the corner of Brattle and Sparks Streets. Faculty members may park in these spaces on a first-come, first-served basis by checking out permits for this lot at the Front Office.

C. Parking shall be provided by the School for all faculty attending Longy Faculty Meetings scheduled by the School.
